Sage Geosystems and Meta Partner on Advanced Geothermal

On August 26, 2024, Meta announced a partnership with Sage Geosystems to deliver up to 150 MW of new geothermal power to support Meta's data center growth. Sage Geosystems will utilize its Geopressured Geothermal Systems (GGS) to meet this goal. The first phase of this project aims to be operational in 2027.

This announcement comes on the heels of the NV Energy–Google partnership, which included 115 MW of advanced geothermal power as part of their Clean Transition Tariff. These partnerships highlight the growing importance of clean firm energy sources while energy demand is increasing dramatically due in part to the rise of data centers.
